

Car Show Etiquette

By fondly reflecting on our former days and uniting us over our common bond, we frequent car cruises and shows, a great activity to escape the rapidly changing, and sometimes troubling world. But political and societal trends have leaked into other aspects of entertainment in our lives such as sports. These same political trends promote a sense of entitlement, envy, and a lack of both individual responsibility and respect for others' property.

While we hobbyists do value and respect others' property (especially with "skin in the game" as exhibited by our own examples of pride and joy), its becoming more common for non-hobbyists to show up at our events. Unfortunately, this is where the spillover can potentially occur when these attendees touch or even help themselves to our vehicles without our permission.

Our initial reaction to a stranger putting his hands on our vehicle may be to take a defensive posture and criticize the trespasser. But instead of creating a conflict, a better approach would be to say something like "Hello, do you like the car?" and "Would you like me to show it to you?"



After showing the vehicle and answering his questions say "After I park the car, sometimes people like to come up and touch it. As you can see, this car is a labor of love and I hope that people attending would ask permission before touching it." In other words, it would be better to shame this attendee without directly confronting him or her.

We can also look out for each other- if you notice someone touching a vehicle that you know is not theirs, mention that you know the owner stepped away but will be back if they have any questions. (You are making he or she aware that they are being watched without accosting them.)

Ultimately, we should take this approach to promote interest in our hobby as well by turning a negative into a positive experience.





Preparing Your Vehicle for Sale

When it's time for your classic vehicle to go to a new owner and you have entrusted a consignment dealer or auction to handle the sale, what can you do to help ensure it gets top dollar and there are no problems when you drop it off? The most obvious thing to do is a thorough wash and detail. Not just a quick wash in the driveway, but one that focuses not only on the exterior, but the wheels, undercarriage, trunk, interior and very importantly the engine compartment. Nothing spoils a beautifully detailed vehicle than to open the hood and see grease, oil, dust and dirt. Yes, it's a little bit of work, but important in the overall presentation. Make sure on the way to drop off the car it doesn't get additional dirt on it after all of that hard work. Remove any unnecessary items from the car, especially the old plastic trophies you won at the local car show. Nobody wants those!

When is the last time you checked to see if your title matches the VIN (Vehicle Identification Number) on your vehicle? Is the VIN on the vehicle a proper manufacturers VIN plate or something someone had made at the local engraving shop? Both very important as most dealers or auctions won't take a vehicle with an incorrect title or without a proper VIN plate. Some VIN numbers are very difficult to see as they may have been stamped on the frame and

the VIN may be covered by years of grease or even worse, covered by a new fender or aftermarket part. Both can be fixed, but it certainly slows the process.

Where's that garage door opener and EZ Pass? Probably right above you where you left them (don't forget your sunglasses too). Does your vehicle have wheel locks? Make sure the lug remover is in the vehicle so that doesn't hang up the new buyer. Any paperwork, receipts, factory documents are important to the new owner, and you should make an effort to locate them and include with sale. Write down everything you know about the history and components of the car. A description that says, "red with a 4-speed" is not enough and neither is "the car speaks for itself," it doesn't!

Following these simple guidelines will make the process much smoother and allow you to get top dollar for your classic vehicle while someone else does all the work.



Update on Ethanol-Free Gas Availability

Since the demand for ethanol-free gas has ticked up in the past year or so, if possible, consider its use, especially for vehicles and equipment that sit for weeks or months at a time. If this fuel is not available closeby, you can purchase additives or stablilizers that will extend the life of the fuel for 6 months or more.

If you own a vehicle that is older than 1975 (without a catalytic converter), you can also try Av (aviation) gas. (See locations among the listings on pages). You will need to bring and fill up cans at airport locations. Keep in mind the fuel is rated at least 100 octane and may contain low lead (100LL) content, which may be preferable in 60's to early 70's muscle cars anyway. Of course you can mix 50-50 Av gas with pump gas to at least dilute the 10% ethanol down to 5% as well.

For EPA restricted areas that currently require ethanol, the fuel industry is now attempting to lobby state and local governments to substitute the ethanol for isobutanol. another biofuel. Isobutanol, as tested. helps to reduce "pollutants" as much as ethanol, yet lacks the chemical breakdown that causes damage to our fuel systems. Contact your state and local representatives now to pressure them into accepting this viable alternative.

Restoration Road Map

utomotive restoration is like any other major journey, it is always good to have a "road map" ensuring that you have a clear idea of where you are starting, where you want to go, and how you can make the journey to your dream car as efficient and enjoyable as possible. Fourth, choose your speed. Decide how quickly you want your project to be completed. Do you want to work with a builder to dedicate the time and resources to completing your project by a specified date or for a specific show or occasion? Or, are you looking to take the "scenic route" and work on the project yourself or with friends on a more relaxed pace over the years? 



5 Garage Preparation Tips

1) Control the Environment

Changes in humidity levels, contact with water, and exposure to the sun's UV rays all damage collector cars. To protect yours, invest in some basic weatherproofing. For starters, apply weatherstripping around the exterior perimeter and doors to prevent flood-related damage. Additionally, use insulation in the garage walls and humidity-controlling tools to keep the interior around 50 degrees F.

2. Secure the Space

Since collector cars are valuable, protect your investment with the proper security features. Make sure all garage doors and windows have functioning locks to keep unwanted visitors out. You can also set up security cameras and an alarm system for additional protection.

3. Install Proper Electrical Fixtures

Whether you're doing maintenance work on the car or just admiring it, having the right lighting solution is a must. For a garage storing a classic car, it's best to have bright overhanging light fixtures. Install additional wall outlets along the walls and ceiling. These will power any tools you need without a long extension cord that creates tripping hazards.

4. Check the Ventilation

Proper ventilation is necessary when working with gas, oil, and paints. The fumes are noxious and may cause a variety of health problems if they're inhaled while working.

Keep Critters Out

Rodents and pests can ruin a vehicle's interior, mar the paint job, and destroy electrical systems. Keep them out by ensuring the exterior is sealed, insulated, and clear of food scraps and debris. Restoring an Air-Cooled Porsche



aradoxically, restoring an aircooled Porsche 911 can be both easier and more difficult than restoring a more conventional car. Easier because, quite frankly, they're in some ways simpler—no cooling system with hoses, radiators, and water pumps to worry about. More challenging because they're unique—things like mechanical fuel injection on some models, the precise way that their finned pistons come apart from the case, threaded studs, and unique cylinder head designs that require care and experience.

Then there is the bodywork. Pre-1976 cars were not galvanized, and the numerous closed spaces provided ideal places for rust to attack, even floor pans-when undercoating aged and cracked, or road debris damaged factory finishes—could rust horrifically. And since these pieces are structural, the results could be terrifying.

The best way to start is with a simple triage of the car. Assess the mechanicals starting with the engine. If leakdown numbers look good (around 10% or less deviation between cylinders), consider yourself lucky. The cost of rebuilding Porsche air-cooled engines has skyrocketed lately. Plan for \$25,000 to \$35,000 for a comprehensive job on a 3.0-liter.

Next, get the car up on a lift. Fresh undercoating is a red flag that demands you poke around with a screwdriver to see how sound the metal is. Getting off easy here means a suspension pan and or battery box.

Air-cooled Porsches were meticulously crafted cars that used expensive materials, so a ratty interior can be very pricey to put right. A cracked dash means that the windshield will need to

come out, to say nothing of the cost of a replacing or repairing the dash itself. Proper carpeting is expensive, and just because your car has a leatherette (rather than leather) interior, don't assume you'll get off easy. Proper German vinyl can be nearly as expensive as leather. Missing items like door pockets will be expensive, as will the often overlooked things like the radio. Plan on about \$1,000 installed for a periodcorrect radio. Fortunately, Porsche Classic has upped its game in recent years, making many formerly obsolete parts once again available.

Few things are more rewarding than the feeling of a job well done. And since the values of air-cooled Porsches continue to rise, it makes more and more economic sense to spend what it takes to restore these cars to a good standard, something that frankly wasn't the case until recently.

How to Shop for Reliable Parts

Its inevitable—at some point with your classic, muscle or performance car or truck, you are going to need or want parts. Unfortunately, today the failure rate is one in every three parts. As you may know, this is due to the invasion of Chinese or other foreign sourced aftermarket parts and cheaper

many times is actually more expensive when you factor in durability and labor costs. Keeping this in mind, you can be more careful by taking a little more time to research

what you need when you do your own repairs or installation. (Your experienced, reputable mechanic will recommend what brands or options to look for and what to avoid if their shop will be performing the work.)

Ask the following questions:

Who manufactures the part? Some parts are made under different names than on the box.

Where is the part made?—where possible make sure that the box does not just say "Distributed in U.S. or another location" to throw you off. Sometimes the same part number is made in more than one location (for example—Mexico, Canada or India-in this case choose a North American source)

Check the application for your part with at least two sources— Many times you can go online to cross-reference the brand and part number. This is even more important if you are upgrading to bolton parts to increase performance of your vehicle!

Check online for reputable reviews of the part or comparison between brands where available.

When checking options, see if there is any warranty offered at least against any defects.

Be wary of any brand that is significantly lower in price than its competitors.

> Many times its better to shop in a retail store so you can check fit and finish of the product.



IMPORTANT TIP—In many cases you may be better off having a professional perform moderate to difficult repairs with installations of new parts. If you were to break the new part when attempting to install it yourself, the manufacturer's warranty would not cover you.

Quickjack

For mobile mechanics or "do-ityourselfers" who cannot install a traditional lift in their garages, consider an investment in Quickjack, a portable

hydraulic jacking system. Quickjack can raise any passenger car or truck almost 2 feet off the ground and secures in place with cam locks (although the company recommends jack stands for additional safety). Various models are available handling vehicle weights from 3500lbs (light cars) to 7000lbs (large pickups).

We tested a BL-5000EXT (5000lb) model on a '70 Firebird in order to replace suspension parts and perform maintenance. The unit raises and lowers as well as a



traditional lift (but of

course, not as high.) The system comes with two lifts (one per side), hydraulic pump, hoses, fittings, rubber blocks, up/ down control and instructions and requires 2-3 quarts of hydraulic (trans) fluid. Prices start at 1340.00 but the company periodically offers discounts and free shipping at www.quickjack.com.



TIP: KNOW THE DATES ON YOUR TIRES!

For vehicles that are driven regularly: those that are parked outside only have about a 10-year shelf life for safety; for those garaged, 15 years or less. Consider that tire replacement is far less costly than a blowout, which could cause serious damage and/or injury or even death.

-How To Read Date Codes On Tires-

Tires manufactured before 2000: Look for stamped oval on bottom of sidewall. Focus on the last three digits in the oval. The first two of the three represent the week of the year and the last digit is the year. For example, DOT EJ8J DFM 408 equals the 40th week of 1998.

Tires manufactured after 2000: Look for stamped oval next to DOT code. Focus on the last four digits in the oval. The first two represent the week of the year and the last two are the year. For example, DOT ATL2 UMWA 0511 equals the 5th week of 2011, as in image below.
