



Antique & Classic Car Vehicle Identification Numbers (VIN) & Titles



hat's the big deal about Vehicle Identification Numbers and titles? Every car has one, right? Not necessarily!

The Detroit auto manufacturers first introduced the VIN in 1954 due to mass production and keeping track statistically of various models. Usually, they were stamped on a plate, which was located on the doorsill or firewall of the car as well as its related parts. In most cases prior to 1954 the vehicle production sequence number was used.

From 1954 to 1981 there was no standardization for the VIN. It was not until 1982 that Federal law standardized the 17-digit VIN. Thus, cars which have been modified or restored prior to 1982 may have lost or never had a VIN tag on the car. The VIN appears on the title, but it's sometimes nowhere to be found on the car!

Today approximately 27 out of 50 states require a physical VIN inspection to register and license a vehicle when it is brought in from out-of-state. In the mid-Atlantic area Pennsylvania, District of Columbia, Virginia, Delaware, and New Jersey require a physical inspection; Maryland and West Virginia do not. What does this mean?

Any vehicle 25 years and older which is

not used for daily transportation, can be registered, and tagged by just walking into the DMV with a signed title and bill of sale. But it may not have a VIN tag anywhere on the car.

What is even more interesting—fewer than 10 of the 27 states physically verify the VIN when the registration is transferred from within the same state.

All of this is great for people who live in Maryland or West Virginia and buy a vehicle from out-of-state prior to 1982, but what happens when they go to sell it outside of the state?

For this reason, one of the first things to look at before you buy or sell a car in these two states is to see where the VIN is located and verify it matches the title.

If you, or your buyer is in such a predicament, there are businesses that can assist you to locate a 'period correct' plate (appears original) that can be permanently mounted on the car, thus resolving the VIN issue.

Advantages of Ethanol Free Gas for Collector Vehicles



s we have stated in the past, on vehicles and equipment, especially 20 years or older, pure gas is your best solution for their fuel system and engine longevity since ethanol promotes the corrosion of metals and degradation of rubber and fiberglass.

But there are other benefits that are not so obvious. For example, ethanol free gas features a prolonged shelf life of six months to a year vs. three months for an E-10, a typical 10% blend (and perhaps even shorter life for E-15, which you should avoid at all costs!) This means that for short-term storage of six months or less, you may not need a to add a fuel stabilizer before putting your vehicle or equipment to bed for the winter.

Another advantage is an increase in gas mileage up to 10% that you would not achieve by just adding a stabilizer to E-10. Finally use of ethanol free gas lowers our dependence on food crops.

To be fair, there are a few disadvantages for frequently driven vehicles that should not be factored in with our seldom driven collectables. One is the cost per gallon of can be fifty cents to a dollar more for the ethanol free variant.

Also there far fewer locations to pump or obtain cans of pure gas vs traditional E-10 locations due to the EPA mandate of ethanol use in densely populated areas. Meanwhile, a few municipalities have slowly permitted the stand in use of isobutanol, a friendlier option for vintage vehicles. [This year, we list more ethanol free locations in this section—ed.]

Even if you believe that "climate change" is affected from those 10% additional emissions of real gas, they are negated by the 10% savings in fuel economy since ethanol free gas is more efficient than E-10.

Ethanol free gas is available in 87, 89, 90 and 93 grades. As of late, while 93 octane is not always available (call your location first beforehand) 89-90 is sold more frequently. Otherwise, if your muscle machine requires 93 or higher octane, add a readily available octane booster to one of the lower grades. Or instead you can mix racing or aviation low lead (LL) gas on cars and trucks without a catalytic converter.

Despite the hype of the mainstream media, climate alarmists, and the federal government, here are the actual facts as of now:

Testing & Tuning Your Vehicle on a Dyno



While many enthusiasts seek to test and tune their vehicle's performance on a dynamometer, the tools for this technology continue to evolve. Many of us traditionally think of dyno tuning as making a few pulls and adjustments to obtain a higher horsepower and torque number, but that's only a small part of the dyno's usefulness.

There are actually two computers utilized in tuning operations- the first is used by the dyno operator and the second is the laptop used by a second operator inside the vehicle. The latest technology integrates both tuning operations in one laptop, enabling easier comparison and analysis of data which provides a more overall picture of the vehicle's performance from a single operator.

When you are tuning a car, you may want to monitor the changes you're making along with the air/fuel ratio that the dyno is reading, or the power/torque the car is making, or something else that needs to be compared between what the dyno shows occurring, and what the ECU is commanding. This will allow all of that to happen in one screen, simpifying analysis of the data.

In the past, the final verdict and adjustments came only after a road test. But now, the latest dyno technology also contains a virtual drag racing function in the dyno software so you can sample how well how your tuning changes will display results on 1/8, 1/4, or mile tracks before you get there. Virtual road simulations will also account for most of the forces older dynos never did in the past such as the aerodynamics and mass of the vehicle, rolling resistance of the tires, etc.

Look for the hub dyno that incorporates all of these benefits and offers the safest form of testing for up to 7,500 horsepower with its cradle-style dual roller design, where there are two rollers on each side of the vehicle. The machine can also easily be adapted to gas, diesel or E85, two or four wheel drive systems and power adders such as turbocharging or supercharging.

Should You Repaint Your Classic Porsche?

Just like with most other iconic cars, you will need to evaluate if the car is a 100% original, numbers matching and you can live with its current condition. Many purist Porschephiles will claim that original examples will always attain the highest value. Yet Porsche bodies built prior to 1977, not fully or partially galvanized, are even more rust prone, which will necessitate a total body restoration.



Consider also that the entire classic car market demographics are changing whereas today some customized cars can fetch more than their stock siblings. Younger owners may wish to change the color or in some cases, add a turbo spoiler, a ground effects package or make other upgrades. Add the fact that Porsche owners tend to drive their cars more on average (and even in wet conditions) than owners of other classic makes (that may be trailered), so worn parts and tired paint jobs are more commonplace.

Beside the fact that any body parts may require repair or replacement, the proper way to paint a 356, 911, and newer Porsche models is by disassembly of the parts first, which will in fact require a partial to full restoration. In order to replicate the car as when new, the Porsche restorer is tasked with the refitting of precisely engineering parts. These closely formed parts (thus to avoid gaps), have virtually no variances so they all fit together in perfect harmony during assembly. This is the exact reason why

original or reproduced Porsche OEM parts and assembly tools are vital to a proper restoration of the exterior (and interior for that matter) as aftermarket parts may not provide the exact fitment needed. These same principles also apply if your Porsche requires repair from collision damage.

The best way to make this your lasting restoration, is to have all of the OEM panels electrostatically dipped (e-coated) to prevent

future corrosion and provide excellent preparation for the paint to adhere beautifully. Further, engaging a professional, factory certified facility will ensure your Porsche will be renewed to its original showroom condition.

Why Save Your Old Parts?

In the past, without a second thought, we would often discard failed parts or return them to the parts store to get reimbursed for a core charge.

But today with the increasing value of collector cars, replacement parts and changes in the parts industry, here are several reasons to keep your old parts:

1 The failure rate of replacement parts today is as much as 33% (This is why you should always do vour own research to find the best rated correct replacements available.)

2 Fit and fin-ish—According to Herald. net, parts made in China using inaccurate dies may require some modification due to ap-

pearance or fitment issues. Examples include drilling a hole, filing or painting the finish to match the original. Even if you are not aiming for a numbers matching part, you may want the part to match the appearance of other components so your replacement is not so obvious.

In case there are no longer any OEM Istyle or aftermarket replacements available, a fabricator can duplicate your original part but will require yours to serve as a model. (This is especially the case for low production makes and models that have little or no aftermarket.)

If your failed part is an aftermarket example such as a high performance version, the part itself may be the only way to reference a replacement if its original documentation no longer exists. With your old part in hand, a knowledge-

able parts retailer may help you identify or cross reference a match that will work from their inventory or order the correct item. This way, you can compare the original with the replacement to ensure it is a match, avoid returns, restock fees and costly shipping charges.

> When you decide to sell your collector vehicle, most prospective buyers will appreciate parts (even if

> > non-working) that will accompany it. These parts help document the vehicle's service history, especially if no receipts are available and/ or there were known issues common to your particular vehicle such as a recall. No doubt these parts will help you

justify your asking price or help you fetch your reserve at an auction.

6 In the case you or a future owner plan to return your custom vehicle back to factory stock condition, saved OEM parts will increase your vehicle's value. For example, by saving valuable time for a prospective buyer to locate an original part such as a rare air cleaner you automatically increase your vehicle's desirability by including these parts with the sale.

So if you decide to save your old parts, clean, protect and lubricate them where possible. If time permits, you can also remove any rust and restore the finish with fresh primer and paint. Ensure that they are packaged and sealed well in a good container that will protect them from damage and decay.



The #1 Maintenance Item For Your Collector Vehicle

It's not typically thought of as a maintenance procedure, but actually by "keeping it running" you help to ensure your vehicle will continue to keep running normally well into the future. Driving it for twenty minutes or enough time for the engine coolant temperature to reach normal keeps it ideal. By contrast, "parking" your car or truck actually encourages component seizure, overall decay and devaluation.

Unless you have taken the proper steps to store your vehicle on a long-term basis (six months or more), you need to drive or run your car or truck at least once a month. But if your collectible has a computer, operate it at least every two weeks. If you cannot run your car on the street, you can operate it on secured jack stands when all four wheels are safely off the ground and can move freely.

Before your operating ritual, make sure your battery is at a fully charged capacity. While your car is sitting (or better yet just after it was last run), disconnect the battery and/or connect it to a trickle charger [an inexpensive product you can pick up at a retailer such as Battery Warehouse (page 12)]

Once you enter the vehicle, before starting it, first crank your engine 2 - 3 times to circulate the oil 10 to 15 seconds per time. With a cold engine that has been sitting for weeks, all of the oil is at the bottom of the oil pan so this cranking procedure will help circulate the oil. Incidentally, after changing your oil, also employ this cranking procedure before starting a warm engine to avoid metal-to-metal contact to help protect the bearings on an old engine.

On carbureted engines, Stay Off the accelerator before or while cranking to slow the travel of gas to the carb. After the 2nd or 3rd crank, tap on the throttle and release to as you would normally start the engine.



On fuel injected vehicles, since turnover is instantaneous, you will need to interrupt the fuel pump relay and fuel pump circuit first. On cars and trucks with a key, first remove the fuel pump relay and/or if present, the fuse to the fuel pump. These are located in the fuse box and can be identified in your shop or owner's manual. After cranking the engine 2-3 times, replug these so you will be able to start.

On some vehicles with a push button start such as GM or Ford, first hold the accelerator to the floor with your right foot, while also depressing the brake pedal, with the left foot, press the start button and crank for 10 to 15 seconds. (On a manual transmission, you may need to depress the clutch instead of the brake, depending on the vehicle.) Do not release the accelerator and press the start button again to cease the cranking each time. (If you release the accelerator before you again press the start button off, you will rev up a cold engine, which could lead to engine damage). Once back in the ignition "off "position, start the vehicle as normal.

The cranking procedure discussed above may be in your owner's manual, but can also be found online.. Not all makes and models have a push start button cranking option so check with your dealer or mechanic first to obtain their recommendation before attempting.


